As it turned out, he was not a candidate for the diaphragm pacer procedure at this time and continues to use the ventilator to assist his breathing. The family is grateful for the constant attention from the highly competent staff at TIRR and for all of the prayers of friends and family. Thoughts, notes, and cards are a wonderful source of support for them. Eileen Debo goes to see them about once a week, and Chris Pearce goes almost daily, so those two are good sources if you want to check up on the Uttenweilers.
